Using Legos, yarn, cardboard, and poster paint, Michel Gondry has built a career as one of the most inventive directors working today. His obsessively low-tech aesthetic and surrealist take on dreams and memory are unmistakable, whether showcased in videos for Björk, the White Stripes, and Daft Punk, or in feature films like *Eternal Sunshine of the Spotless Mind* and *The Science of Sleep*. Tonight, Gondry talks to curators from the Museum of the Moving Image about his inspirations and work. 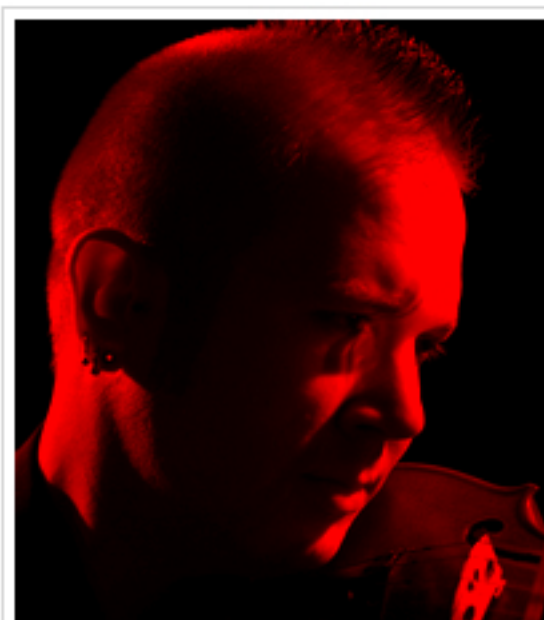

The Boredoms may have pummeled ears in NY and LA with their [88 BoaDrums](#), but the Wordless Music Series throws down the gauntlet with the world premiere of Rhys Chatham's *A Crimson Grail for 200 Electric Guitars*. And Chatham's in-the-round raising of sonic consciousness isn't even the culminating event of this evening dedicated to the "transcendental and ecstatic dimension" of music — that honor goes to the US debut of Manuel Göttsching's *E2-E4*, presented with visual wonderama from the [Joshua Light Show](#). The event begins with a rare performance of works by 13th-century French composer [Pérotin](#), whose gorgeous polyphonic harmonies for chorus are as likely to melt your brain as the more modern pieces.

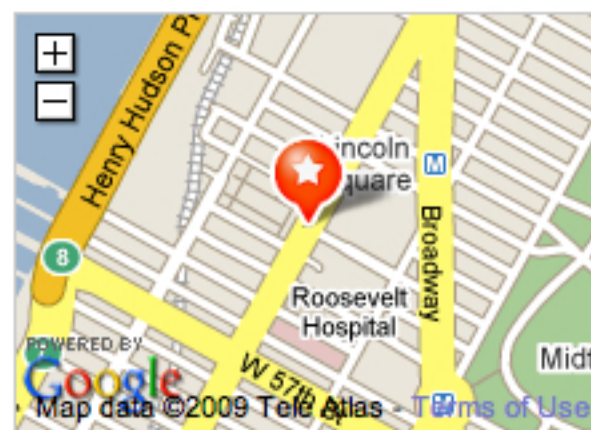

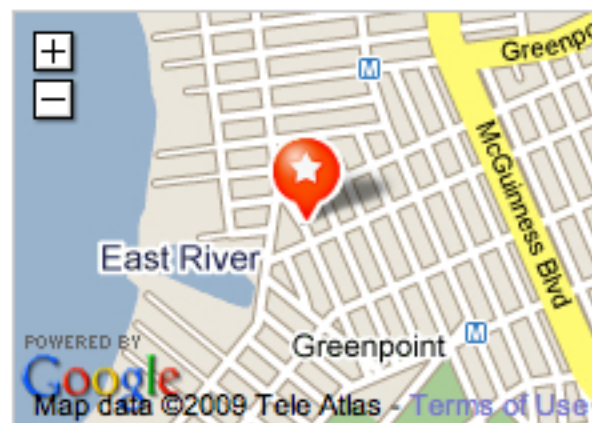

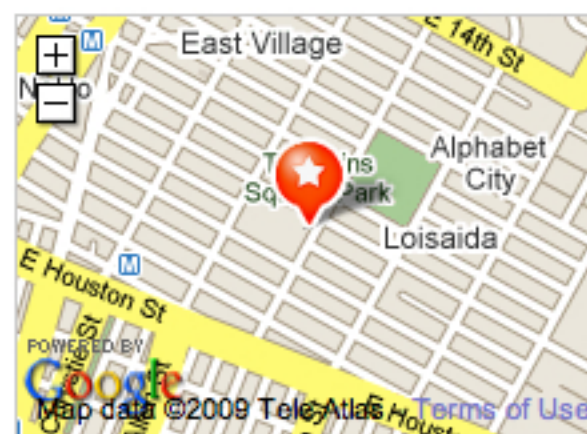

The alternately frenzied and melancholic gypsy brass music of the Balkans has become increasingly popular in the past few years, influencing artists from Gogol Bordello to Beirut. Tonight's show goes straight to the source: Serbia's Boban Markovic, the most celebrated Balkan trumpeter around. He's been the subject of documentaries, won countless awards, and recorded music for Emir Kusturica's iconic *Underground* — and now he passes the torch to his son Marko, who's been touring with his Orkestar for the past few years. NY's Klezmer Brass All Stars (led by Frank London of the Klezmatics) open, bringing the similarly brass-happy music of the Jewish diaspora to the masses.

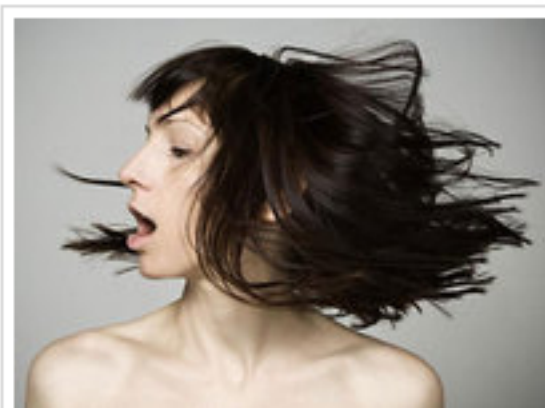

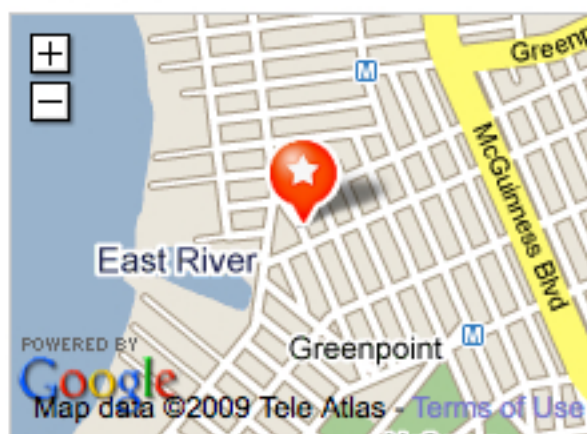
